Arrests at Tiller's Abortion Center are Not Part of KCFL's Plan

KCFL (Kansas Coalition for Life) has kept a continuous prayerful presence at the Tiller Abortion Center in Wichita since Mother's Day 2004, during all hours of its operation.

This continuous presence is part of "Project Love, Prayer, & Persistent Political Action", a seven-year plan to close down the late-term abortion facility at Kellogg and Bleckley, using the power of loving prayer, economics, and long-term political action.

Thus far, all actions of all of KCFL volunteers who are participating in the plan have been, and will continue to be, lawful, peaceful, and prayerful.

Although the KCFL project was in operation on Wednesday, from 6:40 am to 6:18 pm, with volunteers on site all day, none of the people who were arrested were part of KCFL's project.

KCFL considers arrests to be counter-productive in the long run. Lines 556 thru 560 of the KCFL project plan state the following:

"All activities will be peaceful, loving, prayerful events that remain completely within the law.

No one participating in this plan under the name of The Kansas Coalition for Life, Inc. will be intentionally arrested for any reason whatsoever."

Since the KCFL plan has a huge political side to it, and since voters generally frown upon illegal activity, every effort is made by KCFL to keep the actions of all volunteers completely within the law.

The concern of KCFL is that some of the people and churches who are currently evaluating our 7-year plan, and are considering joining the coalition's efforts, may erroneously assume that those arrested were part of our group, simply because the arrests happened at the same location.

NOTE TO ALL KANSAS MEDIA

A summary page of the KCFL Project Love, Prayer, and Persistent Political Action plan was attached to your last News Release sent by fax on May 9, 2004.

The entire plan is 23 pages long and is now on its 4th major revision. Changes to parts of the plan are still on-going in an attempt to accommodate the wishes of as many Christian leaders in Kansas as possible.

Nevertheless, the entire Revision-4 of the plan is available to Kansas media by fax. The plan is sent with the understanding that parts of the plan are still a work in progress, and are subject to change, and therefore should not be quoted directly.
