Abortionist Tiller Chooses the Day After Thanksgiving to Burn the Bodies of Late-Term Babies.

Wichita shoppers unknowingly sprinkled with the burnt ash of fetal remains.

In a scene that could have been taken directly out of the movie, "Schindler's List", smoke and ash billowed out of the smokestack of the on-site incinerator/crematorium located at Kellogg and Bleckley Streets in Wichita, Kansas today, starting at about 8:30 this morning.

The black, charred, ash-like flakes of skin and human remains that rose above the Tiller abortion facility, along with the smoke, were carried by a light south wind, and deposited onto the hoods and windshields of unsuspecting holiday shoppers on Kellogg Avenue and Kellogg Drive.
