By ONE VOTE the Kansas Senate Fails to Override Veto of Late-term Abortion Bill

Topeka, KS - The Kansas Senate failed to override Governor Mark Parkinson's mis-guided veto of a bill that would have helped authorities determine if post-viability abortions done in Kansas comply with the law. The vote fell just one short of the 27 votes needed to override.

On Monday, May 3rd, the Kansas House had successfully voted to override Parkinson's veto of HB 2115.

The bill would have mandated common sense reporting of late-term abortions on viable babies. Right now, because of inadequate reporting, authorities cannot tell if these late term abortions are being done legally or illegally – and the corrupt governor of Kansas wants to keep it that way! In fact, evidence shows that the vast majority of late-term abortions done in Kansas are being done illegally.
