

Understanding the 2007 ProLife Signature Ad

To understand why the 2007 ProLife Signature Ad is such a profound statement, and why the ProAborts are so mad about it, you must know a little about **Chelsea Brooks** and **Christin Gilbert**.

On the opposite side is a News Release that details the death of Christin Gilbert and her unborn child. Christin's death received almost no media attention because her death was caused by a late-term abortion.

In contrast, the death of Chelsea Brooks, a pregnant teenager who was killed criminally, received intense media coverage and is still in the news today, due to the trial of her killers.



Chelsea Brooks was 14 years old, and nine months pregnant at the time of her death. She was killed because she refused to have an abortion.

The father of Chelsea's unborn child wanted Chelsea to have an abortion because the baby would have provided evidence of statutory rape.

When Chelsea refused to have an abortion, he took the next "logical" step, and simply paid someone \$500 to have her, and their unborn child killed.

Chelsea Brooks' partially buried body was found in a wheat field ten days after she was discovered to be missing.

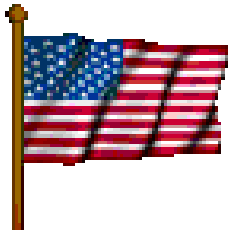
Under current law, the killing of Chelsea Brooks was illegal, while the killing of Christin Gilbert was perfectly legal.

Our point is to show the world, that the deaths of these two teens and their babies are similar in many ways.

From a moral perspective, these killings are indeed identical acts.

Hence, our theme for the 2007 ProLife Signature Ad is: **A Distinction Without a Difference**. Consider the following:

1. In both cases, the primary objective was to kill the unborn baby.
2. In both cases, the death of the baby's mother was only a secondary result of the primary objective, which was the protection of a rapist.
3. Neither teenage mother, Chelsea Brooks nor Christin Gilbert, wanted to kill their own unborn child.
4. In both cases, a hired killer did the job in exchange for money.
5. In both cases, it was selfish people around Chelsea and Christin who should have been supportive of them and their child, who wanted to kill the "viable" unborn child, that each of these teenagers was carrying.
6. Both Chelsea and Christin, along with their babies, died a horrifyingly painful and traumatic death at the hands of those whom they trusted.

8. Even if everything had gone as intended, neither the killing of Christin's nor Chelsea's unborn child would have had merit, nor would it have provided a societal benefit. The protection of rapists by street criminals OR by abortionists is morally unacceptable.

Death of Teen Caused by a Botched Abortion at Tiller's Late-Term Abortion Facility

Christin A. Gilbert, age 19, of Keller, Texas, died of complications stemming from a third-trimester abortion, according to recently released autopsy results.

Christin, a girl with Down's Syndrome, had been raped and became pregnant in 2004.

On January 10, 2005, her family bought her to the Tiller late-term abortion facility in Wichita, Kansas, for an abortion, where it was estimated that her pregnancy was 28 weeks in gestation.

Tiller, or one of his hired abortionists, injected a poison called "digoxin", through Christin's abdominal wall, directly into the heart of her unborn child, with a needle guided by ultrasound imaging.

Next, Christin was sent to a nearby LaQuinta Inn Motel, which Tiller used as a labor and delivery room, to wait for the delivery of her dead child.

The following day Christin was placed in the family van where she delivered her dead baby before arriving at Tiller's clinic.

Once at Tiller's clinic she was given a D&C and a dose of RU-486 to insure that all of the after-birth tissue had been removed.

Christin was then sent back to the motel room where her condition worsened.

The following day, Christin again returned to Tiller's clinic where she was treated for dehydration even though an undiagnosed infection was raging and was beginning to take its toll on her health. That night Christin began to hemorrhage, vomit, and periodically lost consciousness.

Early in the morning, on January 13th Christin was choking on her vomit and had passed out; so her family brought her back to the Tiller Abortion Chamber a fourth time.

At about 9:00 am on January 13th KCFL volunteer, Judi Weldy, who takes part in the continuous proLife presence at the Tiller abortion facility, reported that an ambulance rescue was underway. Other pro-life groups were notified.

Once at Wesley Medical Center's Emergency Room, Christin died of Sepsis and general organ failure.

Christin was loved by those who knew her. She had served as the "bat-girl" for her high school's baseball team and she had a joyous loving attitude.

We mourn the death of both Christin and her unborn child. ### (PAGE-2)
