Question: *What is Project Love, Prayer and Persistent Political Action?*

Answer: *It is a 7-year plan to shut down the Tiller Abortion Center by the power of loving prayer, economics, and changes in state law.*

It is a fact. When ProLife people are on-site, at Kellogg and Bleckley Streets in Wichita, the number of abortion-bound clients who enter the Tiller Abortion facility is reduced.

Furthermore, by the power of prayer, some abortion-bound clients leave the abortion chamber and opt to give life, when there are loving people on-site, who are willing to talk to them and help them.

The Tiller Abortion Chamber has stayed in business over the past 32 years by simply scheduling around, (or waiting-out), the various ProLife events that have taken place. When the ProLife crowds left, it was always back to business-as-usual.

Project LPPPA makes that strategy impossible! How? By always being there when the abortion chamber is open for business.

At the same time, drawing from an ever-expanding pool of volunteers who are willing to spend time in prayer at the abortion chamber, we are reinforcing the political efforts of Christians

in Kansas who are working toward the legal protection of the unborn.



Project LPPPA operates completely within the law, depending on the awesome power of loving prayer, coupled with economics, and long-term political action to achieve our goals.

As Christians, we cannot continue to ignore the fact that each late-term abortion in

In the Book of Leviticus 19:16, God warns us: **"...You shall not stand by idly when your neighbor's life is at stake."**

In 1993, when Pope John Paul II The Great, was in Denver, Colorado, he said: *"America!! – You must have the courage, America, to come out of your homes – and out of your comfortable lifestyles now – and come out into the streets – and into the public places – and you must shout the Gospel of Life from the rooftops!"*

"America!! Do not be afraid! Jesus Christ is with you!"

"America!! You must come into solidarity with the victim – the unborn child!!"

Every day that the Tiller Abortion Chamber is open for business, KCFL volunteers exercise their First Amendment Rights by placing 167 white Crosses on city property adjacent to the walls of the fortress-like death chamber. Each Cross represents one child killed at the Tiller Abortion facility EVERY MONTH. However, in order to exercise our First Amendment Rights, we must have people present in attendance with the Crosses throughout the day, or The City of Wichita will confiscate the Crosses.

The Crosses have a huge impact. Silently, the Crosses say much more than any person could, setting a somber mood for the entire abortion facility and helping to save lives.

The Tiller abortion facility is open for business for an average of about 11 hours per day. Keeping people present on-site daily, in solidarity with the unborn, rain or shine, is a difficult task, but a spiritually uplifting one. Encouraged by the fact that we are already seeing a reduction in the number of abortion clients going through Tiller's gate; we have managed to keep a continuous presence on-site since Mother's Day 2004. With your help and prayers, this project will continue to grow in its effectiveness.
