KCFL's Project LPPPA was Successful & Effective in 2004.

5'365.2 hours on-site, no arrests, a 10% reduction in the number of abortions, and an average of one "SAVE" every two days.

The Kansas Coalition for Life had a very successful year in 2004.

Project Love, Prayer, and Persistent Political Action, (LPPPA) maintained a continuous prayerful presence at the gate of the late-term Tiller Abortion facility in Wichita from Mother's Day, thru the end of the year. Volunteers put in a total of 5'362.2 hours on-site, and in doing so, reduced the number of abortions at that facility by about 10%. This was accomplished without a single arrest.

The on-site results show an average of one "save" every two days, proving that we do not have to wait for a change in the make-up of the US Supreme Court to have an impact on late-term abortions in Kansas.

The attached "Church Participation Listing" shows that where people are aware of what we are doing, there is a tremendous willingness to help. Even those who live in other states are willing to travel long distances to help.
