On the 1-Year Anniversary of Ambulance Call # 3, (death of Christin Gilbert) KCFL asks; “What about Ambulance Call # 4”?



What about Ambulance Call # 4, on February 17, 2005. Is this Tiller-victim-client dead or alive?

On the anniversary of KCFL’s Ambulance Call #3, which is now known as the death of Christin Gilbert, (see KCFL’s September 2005 News Release, attached) KCFL Director, Mark Gietzen urges the media in Wichita to follow-up on Ambulance Call # 4.

The day was February 17, 2005, about one month after Ambulance Call # 3, the time was about 11:02 am, when

KCFL volunteers, Diana Helten and Terry Read, on-site at Tiller’s late-term abortion facility, witnesses and photographed Ambulance Call # 4.

However, unlike previous calls, Sedgwick County 911 Dispatch has declined KCFL’s request for a copy of the 911 call, and the outcome of this call remains a mystery to KCFL and other ProLife groups.

One of the reasons that KCFL suspects a possible 2nd death-of-the-victim-mother, in as many months, is because the ambulance was in a hurry to get into Tillers, but once the paramedics went inside, and came back out, they were no longer in a hurry. They even waited several minutes after loading the person or the body before leaving.
